

### NAMBITI PLAINS LODGE – GENERAL INFORMATION

- Nambiti Plains Lodge is situated in the Nambiti Game Reserve (Memorial Gate) and is roughly 3.5 hours from Durban and 4.5 hours from Johannesburg (visit our website for directions)
- Nambiti Plains is a **malaria-free area**
- Recommended time of arrival is from 12:00 with check-in to the rooms from 14:00. Rooms are vacated between 10:00am and 10:30am. **Gates strictly open at 06:00 and close at 18:00**
- When traveling take into account that game drives usually start at 3:30pm on your day of arrival and that late arrivals could possibly result in missing your first game drive. Please check with the Lodge as game drive times may vary with the seasons.
- Lunch is usually served between 13h00 to 14h30 (times may change), however late arrivals can still enjoy a small High Tea.
- **Please contact the Lodge when passing Ladysmith** as to avoid a waiting period as the Lodge is situated a distance from the gate.
- Guests will be required to sign an indemnity form before arrival, sign in at the gate, then proceed with private vehicles to the undercover guest parking from where a guide will collect you in open safari vehicles and you will be driven to the lodge.

### NAMBITI PLAINS LODGE – CONFIRMATION AND PAYMENT DETAILS

- **Provisional bookings are held for 4 days** before being released (see cancelation policy) – we require a 50% deposit within this time to hold a booking.
- **Full accommodation payment to be made 30 days prior to arrival.**
- The Nambiti Reserve charge a conservation levy per person per night that will be added to the guests' extras account and settled upon departure – this is a mandatory charge
- All payments by agents/operators for accommodation to be made via electronic bank transfer
- Rates are inclusive of 15% vat and subject to change without prior notice.
- **Guests are responsible for any bank charges that may be incurred for EFT Payments.**
- International bank transfers for amounts totalling less than R25 000 will incur an additional +-R270 bank surcharge – amounts totalling more than R25 000 will incur a surcharge of 0.5% of the accommodation amount. This may vary from bank to bank and will be for your own account.
- Extras to be settled upon departure at the Lodge and may be settled by cash, Master or Visa card only. We do not accept Diners, American Express and cheques.

#### CANCELLATIONS:

Cancellations must be made in writing and conditions of cancellation are as follows:

- Less than 14 days prior to confirmed arrival date = 100% cancellation fee
- 15 to 45 days prior to confirmed arrival date = 50% cancellation fee
- 46 to 120 days prior to confirmed arrival date = loss of 20% deposit
- 121 days and more prior to confirmed arrival date = full refund

## NAMBITI PLAINS ROOMS and FACILITIES

Nambiti Plains Lodge is a small, intimate 5\* Lodge that only accommodates 14 guests (7 rooms). We are one of the few Lodges on Nambiti Game Reserve not fenced in which means you have the opportunity to view the animals up close and personal in camp, from the comfort of your deck or the main lodge decks. We are built on the edge of a waterhole frequently visited by various animals which give our guest a unique bush experience. The Lodge is decorated in an earthy minimalistic style to give you the same feeling as that of the wide-open space of the plains in front of the Lodge.

Two sets of Luxury Suites can be booked as family suites (accommodate 4 people in two rooms.) The Luxury Suites utilized as family units consist of one building, a common entrance leading to two separate and private rooms; a solid packed stone wall divides the two rooms. All suites have private decks fitted with a table and two chairs as well as two sun loungers. Each suite come as an XL King bed but can also be accommodated as 2 ¾ size twin beds (extra length). **What to pack (visit our website for a detailed list):**

- Clothing should be comfortable and durable, cool cottons are ideal. Neutral colours are preferable.
- An all-weather outdoors or bush jacket should be packed for both the summer and winter months, as we might experience cooler weather early mornings even in summer months.
- Sturdy, comfortable, walking boots or track shoes are recommended. Doctors certificate to state you are fit to walk if you are over 65 years and intending to join us on a Walking Safari.
- In winter ensure you pack for **cold** conditions – thick jackets, a scarf, gloves and beanie are recommended. Our shop also stocks these items.
- During summer months, it is important that you bring sun protection and a hat. You will find sunscreen and caps in our shop
- Important documentation (travel insurance) and reading material.
- Please note that insurance carriers do not allow the distribution of medicines and we therefore highly recommend guests carry the basic requirements as they are not available at the Lodge: Headache tablets, Imodium, any allergy medicines that may be required
- Camera equipment and batteries
- Binoculars (you can rent a pair at the lodge – first come first serve apply)

### NAMBITI PLAINS LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS

Nambiti Plains is situated only 28km North of Ladysmith, Kwa-Zulu Natal, roughly a 4-and-a-half-hour drive from Johannesburg and 3-and-a-half-hour from Durban.

Guests will sign an indemnity form and all private vehicles will be parked at the undercover parking, from where the guide will collect the guests to the Lodge in an open game viewer.

### DIRECTIONS FROM JOHANNESBURG

- Head towards Ladysmith on the N3. Once you have entered KwaZulu Natal via Van Reenen, look out for the Ladysmith Toll off-ramp (at the bottom of Van Reenen's Pass).
- Turn left and drive toward Ladysmith on the R103. When you arrive in Ladysmith, drive straight through, following the N11 Road
- Guests are required to call the lodge on + 27 (0) 71 680 4584 once they reach Ladysmith.
- Follow the N11 through Ladysmith towards Newcastle and continue on this road for +- 20km
- Ignore the signs that say Nambiti as this will lead you to the South Gate / Woodlands Gate.
- Drive until you see the Nambiti Plains Lodge sign (Elandslaagte / Glencoe / Dundee) and turn right.
- You will then be on the Glencoe / Dundee road R602. Travel for +-2.3km.
- Turn right at Elandslaagte / Nambiti Plains Lodge sign - P555 (dirt road)
- Cross the railway line - follow Elandslaagte sign for 200m
- Turn left following Nambiti Plains Lodge / Elandslaagte / Memorial Gate sign
- Drive 3.8km to Nambiti Game Reserve North Gate / Memorial Gate

### DIRECTIONS FROM DURBAN

- Head towards Ladysmith on the N3 - Take the **Ladysmith / Bergville Toll Off Ramp (exit 230)**.
- Turn right and travel in the direction of Ladysmith, drive straight through Ladysmith on the N11 Road towards Newcastle.
- Guests are required to call the lodge on +27 (0) 71 680 4584 once they reach Ladysmith.
- Follow the N11 through Ladysmith towards Newcastle and continue on this road for +- 20km
- Ignore the signs that say Nambiti as this will lead you to the South Gate / Woodlands Gate.
- Drive until you see the Nambiti Plains Lodge sign (Elandslaagte / Glencoe / Dundee) and turn right.
- You will then be on the Glencoe / Dundee road R602. Travel for +-2.3km.
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### NAMBITI PLAINS ACTIVITIES (All activities are subject to availability; prices are subject to change without prior notice)

#### Walking Safari (2-3 hour excursion, minimum 2 pax) – On request and subject to availability

Experience the Bush in a different way on foot. Learn how to track animals and identify spoor as well as observing the smaller things often overlooked on game drives.

R 850 per person

Recommended for stays of 3 nights or longer. Can fit between morning and evening game drives. Bush Walks carry a minimum legal age of 16 years and any person over 65 years old should have a medical certificate of fitness.

**Bass Fishing (Fully tailor-made activity, 2½ hour, minimum 2 pax) – Daily**

During the summer months, the dams and rivers are alive with a variety of Large-Mouth Bass, Small-Mouth Bass and Tilapia. Relax and take a break for an hour or two with a rod in one hand and beverage in the other and immerse yourself in the tranquillity and sounds of the bush. Fishing is on a catch-and-release basis. Available at any time of the day and can fit between morning and evening game drives.

**Bush Picnic (Fully tailor-made activity, minimum 2 pax) – Daily on request**

Spectacular picnic somewhere in the Nambiti Bush. Includes open game viewer transfer through the reserve, bush picnic (either on the traditional way or with table and chairs), private chef and/or host. Recommended for stays of 3 nights or longer.

**Romantic Package (Fully tailor-made activity, minimum 2 pax) – Daily on request**

Spoil your loved one with this romantic package. Includes romantic turn down with bubble bath, bottle of Method Cap Clasiq on ice, special snacks and a private dinner on your deck under the stars. Recommended for stays of 3 nights or longer.

**Night Drive (2-hour excursion, minimum 2 pax) – Daily on request**

Experience the sights and sounds of the bush at night. You will have the opportunity to see the more elusive nocturnal animals' resident on the Nambiti Reserve such as porcupine, large spotted genet, jackal, aardvark and the ever-elusive leopard. Recommended for stays of 3 nights or longer.

**Star Gazing (Fully tailor-made activity, minimum 2 pax) – Daily on request**

In the evening, after dinner, your guide will take the opportunity to discuss the night skies. The Milky Way is a phenomenal sight on a clear night and the plethora of constellations such as Orion, Taurus the Bull, the Southern Cross, Scorpio and many others that will keep you in wonder.

**Battlefields Tours (Fully tailor-made activity, minimum 2 pax) – Daily**

The war of the Zulu Kings and the British Empire took place in the hills surrounding Nambiti Game Reserve. An important part of the British / Boer history lies within the boundaries of Nambiti as the Battle of Elandslaagte took place around and on parts of the reserve.

If you wish to explore the battlefields of this momentous occasion for a day or even for a few days for a more detailed approach the opportunity is available.

Tour 1 – Isandlwana and Rourkes Drift

Tour 2 – Battle of Blood River and Talana

Tour 3 – Ladysmith Siege, Battle of Colenso, Cemetery and Gun Hill and Spionkop
